#### 2. Treasurer's report- Nic Whitson

- 1. <u>Eftpos machines</u> for General Accounts too expensive to go ahead with. Other option found Square device, but there is a problem opening a functional Square account due to the lack of an 'incorporated number' on our Incorporation Certificate. Hannah and Ella are looking into this.
- 2. <u>Canteen</u> is losing money- average of \$298 per week. Price increase needed to generate \$300 a week to stay even. Preferably \$400 a week. Heather is to look into this with Belinda and Jo and come up with a course of action ASAP.
- 3. Other accounts: <u>Uniform Account</u> \$56,042.42 <u>General Account</u> \$39,667.92 <u>Total Funds Available \$96,088.74</u> Slightly down from Feb Balance \$96,811.25 More detailed report filed with this (wouldn't cut and paste here with the graphs)
- 4. Last <u>Disco</u> made \$3758.11. <u>Easter Event</u> \$88.41. <u>Mother's Day</u> can't actually be calculated yet as all figures weren't in.

### 3. Vice President/ Events - Heather Cervantes

<u>Mother's Day Celebrations</u>- great success with heaps of teachers and volunteers and dads helping out and fabulous sponsors like Bunnings/ InBloom and Chill Bar. Over 90 mums attended. <u>Gorgeous Gift Stall</u> was also a great success: in total made over \$1000 (precise figures to come)

As president, hoping to get Sustainability Markets up and running. Organise a Readathon, offer support to the Subcommittees and a survey to staff for fundraising- deadline given of end of week of 26 of May for them to return this.

#### 5. Canteen report – None

### 6. Uniform shop report- Rachel Ballesty

Submission of options for a <u>fleece</u> to be added to the uniform menu. Three options were offered. 1st if from Profile Apparel and already used at Beacon Hill Public. Would retail at \$47 with embroidery and in navy blue.

The two alternative options were from LW Reid -one with zipped pockets and the other one lined

Agreed to go with Rachel's suggestion of option 1 but to keep the zippered jacket and pull over for the moment and possibly do polling later. Lead time 5-6 weeks Rain jacket mooted but not much support as not needed that often.
